Welcome to the 8th annual Cans4Books, sponsored by Midland Recycling & A-Can Recycling!

In honor of School Library Media Month, for every pound of aluminum recycled in **April**, Midland Recycling and A-Can Recycling will give an additional 5 cents per pound to designated Lincoln-Lancaster County elementary or middle school libraries.

Participating in Cans4Books is easy: All during the month of April, simply take your cans to **A-Can Recycling** or **A & J Recycling**. You can either:

1. Donate all, or a portion of your recycling refund, which will be added to the 5 cents per pound donation from the recycling centers
2. Keep your aluminum refund and the schools will still receive the 5 cents per pound donation

In addition, you can make the donation in the name of a student(s). Schools **AND** students are eligible for prizes! Schools with the top dollar earnings (per capita) will win cash (**1st - \$400, 2nd - \$200 and 3rd - \$100**). Students with the largest total aluminum weight donated will win a T-shirt, environmental award and Lee Booksellers Gift Certificates (**1st - \$75, 2nd - \$50 and 3rd - \$25**). Plus the top 30 students that individually collect the most cans will receive free Pepsi Products!
