Friendly Fifth-Grade Reminders

NEW WRITING MODE – Our current writing mode is story. Last week students wrote stories about Paul Revere and this week they will continue to write stories about the time period around the Revolutionary War. Students will also continue writing in a genre of their choice. In the following two weeks students will be learning about conflict, point of view, and morals. The story unit will conclude with fables and young children's stories.

NEW READING THEME – The new reading theme is "Voices of the Revolution". Your student is reading stories about the Revolutionary War time period. Take some time to talk to them about the founders of our country. taking the Theme Test all week long. Please help them get to bed early so they can do their best on this test.

SOCIAL STUDIES AND SCIENCE – The second CRT in each subject will be given next week. Review packets will be sent home at the end of this week, or the beginning of next week. Please take some time to help your student study for these important tests. Mrs. Heil/Hauder's students will be taking the Social Studies CRT over famous explorers and Mr. Schwanke's students will be taking the Science CRT over chemistry.

MATH – Our new math chapter is all about factors, multiples, and fractions. Your student is learning how to list the factors and multiples of a number. Also they are learning how to compare fractions, turn improper fractions into mixed numbers, and put a fraction in simplest form. This is a long chapter and after it we will be working on decimals.
