### Friendly Fifth-Grade Reminders:

**WRITING** – All students have written a personal narrative and this paper has been placed in their Middle School file. Currently all students are writing poetry. The next focus in writing will be on descriptive paragraphs.

**READING THEME** – The first reading theme is called Nature's Fury. This theme is all about storms and nature. The first story is called "Earthquake Terror". It is about two children who experience an earthquake on an island. The second story is called "Eye of the Storm". It is about a storm chaser named Warren Faidley. The final story is called "Volcanoes". It is a nonfiction story about volcanoes.

### SOCIAL STUDIES AND SCIENCE –

The first quarter focus for Science is Rocks and Minerals. Mr. Schwanke's class will take the CRT on the week of October 5.

The first quarter focus in Social Studies is Native American Tribes. Students will discuss every major Native American Tribe in the Western Hemisphere.

**MATH** – Our goal is that Lakeview 5<sup>th</sup> grade will average 85% on all math tests. The chapter one average was 78%. The chapter two average was 84%. The next test is Chapter 3—Multiplication. Practice those multiplication times tables so that this test will be easy! This test is all about multiplying by single and double-digit numbers. Students must remember to place the automatic zero in the ones place value when multiplying by double-digit numbers. The chapter four math test is all about dividing. Help your student prepare for these tests by sitting down with him/her and practicing those timed tests or flash cards for multiply and divide.
