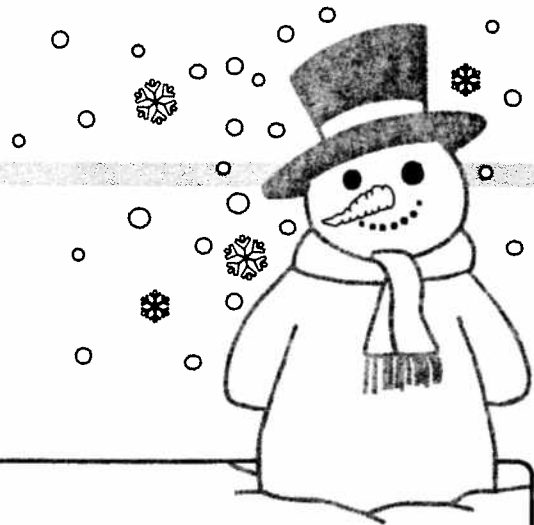

In reading we talked about the Alphafriends Hattie Horse H, Andy Apple A, and Vinny Volcano V. We added the words 'to', 'we', and 'a' to our word wall. We introduced the '-at' word family (i.e. bat, cat, sat). Next we will work on the letters 'c' and 'p'. We will add the words 'at', and 'me' to the word wall. We are going to start working with the '-an' word family (i.e. can, tan, man).

In math we finished talking about the numbers 6 through 10. We are beginning a new geometry and fractions unit. We will be focusing on solid shapes, such as sphere, cylinder, cube, and cone.

In science we completed our sink, float, and dissolve unit. We are moving on to body basics.
